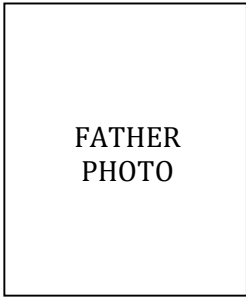
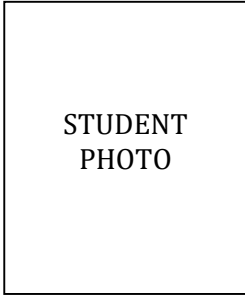

The Constitution of India

Preamble

We, the people of India, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a Sovereign socialist secular democratic republic and to secure to all its citizens:

- Justice – Social, Economic and Political;
- Liberty – of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;
- Equality – of status and of opportunity, and to promote among them all;
- Fraternity – assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation;

In our constituent assembly this twenty – sixth day of November, 1949 do We hereby adopt, enact and give to ourselves this constitution.

Fundamental Duties (Chapter IV A)

Articles 51 – A

Fundamental Duties – It shall be the duty of every citizen of India:

- a. to abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;
- b. to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom;
- c. to uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;
- d. to defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;
- e. to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;
- f. to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture;
- g. to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers and wild life, and to have compassion for living creatures;
- h. to develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;
- i. to safeguard public property and to abjure violence;
- j. to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of Endeavour and achievement.
- k. to provide opportunities for education by the parent the guardian, to his child, or a ward between the age of 6-14 years as the case may be.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission to this school is restricted by conditions of age, ability and conduct. Hence the applicants for admission will be tested and admitted to the standards, if they are found fit.

- The age of admission to LKG is four plus and to standard I is six plus on or before May 31st with corresponding increase of age for the higher classes.
- Registration for KG admission starts from 1st week of November every year. To other classes it starts from 4th week of November.
- A child seeking admission has to register his/her name. He/she has to undergo for a pre-knowledge assessment test. There is no written test for LKG.
- Admissions to the higher classes are given on the basis of the availability of the seats after the prescribed entrance test.
- Admission form must be duly filled in only by the parent of the child who is seeking admission.
- Parents should take great care to fill in the correct date of birth as this will, in no case be altered later.
- Admissions to higher classes will not be granted until a Transfer Certificate from the former school is produced.

However, priority shall be given to the following categories on the basis of merit:

- Children of transferable and non-transferable central government employees including ex-servicemen.
- Children of transferable and non-transferable state government employees.
- Children of transferable and non-transferable employees of autonomous bodies, public sector undertakings, Institutes of higher learning of Government of India & Government of Tamil Nadu including ex-servicemen.

- Children from any other category other than the above said including the Children of foreign nationals who are located in India due to their work or for any personal reasons.
- Children from any other category other than the above said including the Children of Indian nationals who are located outside India due to their work or for any personal reasons.
- When applying for admission the following documents are to be submitted:
 1. Birth Certificate
 2. Transfer Certificate
 3. Progress Report / Mark List (from the school last studied)
 4. Copy of Aadhar card
 5. Any other document as needed
- The school authorities reserve the right to refuse admission to a pupil without assigning any reason.

WITHDRAWAL

- Generally, withdrawals are not permitted at the end of the school year, unless such withdrawals are warranted by the transfer of the parents or guardians to the other places. In such cases notice of withdrawal must be given in writing.
- Application for TC in the prescribed form should be submitted at the office by the parents at least two weeks in advance.
- The Transfer Certificate TC will not be issued unless all dues to the school have been paid.
- The school authorities reserve the right to refuse admission to a pupil without assigning any reason. They also reserve the right to dismiss the student whose diligence or progress in studies is constantly unsatisfactory, irregular attendance, habitual idleness, disobedience or defiance of authority, lack of sufficient improvement in studies and conduct even after warnings are sufficient reasons for the dismissal of a student.



- A student who fails twice in the same class will be sent with his/ her TC from the school.
- The decision of the principal will be final in this matter.
- Any parent willing to obtain TC from the school shall make the request in writing to the principal before 31st March of every year.
- All withdrawals of students should take place before 1st May of every year. If a student withdraws from the school after 1st May and before the reopening of the school, the student must pay the first term fees. If the student withdraws in the middle of a term, fees have to be paid for the full year including the transport fee.

EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

- The school holds Periodic Assessment (PA) and Terminal examinations during the academic year. Besides these, class evaluation is conducted at regular intervals.
- Promotion is granted on the basis of performance of the pupil for the first terminal and second terminal.
- A minimum attendance of 85% is required for the promotion.
- No re - examination will be conducted in any subject.
- Absence or failure in any subject excludes a student from being recorded in the order of merit.
- The decisions of the school authorities will be final with regard to the promotion.



FEE REMITTANCE

- School fees should be paid in three terms on or before the dates as informed from time to time by the management of the school without fine. The fee can be paid as cash in the cash counter and receipts for which will be issued by the cashier.
- If any parent of the student, due to exceptional circumstances is unable to pay the fees on due date, they are directed to meet principal and give a written requisition and obtain extension of time for payment. However, fee must be paid within the extended time without fail.
- No student will be allowed to sit for the terminal examination unless all the fees have been paid up to date.
- The principal / management has the right to increase the tuition fees or any other fees and also to introduce any kind of additional fee even during the academic year as and when there is need.
- School accepts fees through Google pay and debit card swiping. Direct payment to the school bank account can also be made through NEFT/RTGS.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Dear Parents, guardians and students,

You are requested to cooperate with the school in the observance of all rules and regulations laid down below and those announced by the school authorities as and when it is required.

A) GENERAL RULES TO THE STUDENTS

1. Every student shall respectfully wish the teachers irrespective of the classes they handle.
 2. Stand up and wish a teacher or a visitor when he/ she enters or leaves the classroom.
 3. Maintain silence in the absence of a teacher.
 4. Behave well even outside the school in such a way that their teachers and parents are proud of them.
 5. During the class hours, order and silence need to be maintained.
 6. Running about, playing or shouting inside the school campus is strictly prohibited.

7. Student must come to school always on time neither too early nor late. No student is allowed to remain in the school premises after class hours.
 8. The school premises and your classroom should always be kept neat and clean. Since cleanliness is next to Godliness, every student shall consider cleanliness of dress and person as an essential virtue.
 9. Any kind of damage to the school properties, assets must be immediately reported to the principal. The cost of the damage will be charged to the respective student(s). Who has caused the damage.
 10. Every student should attend the morning assembly. Their movement from class to assembly and back, should be in an orderly manner. They should move silently but smartly in single line under the guidance of the class teacher or class leader.
 11. Pupils from one class are not allowed to be in other class room during intervals. When pupils move along the corridor to another class or while going up and coming down the stair-case, the rule is KEEP LEFT.
 12. Prayers must be recited with respect and devotion. Pupils should not move about at the time of prayer and should be in attention while singing the National Anthem.
 13. Newspapers, periodicals, transistors radios, mobile phones, electronic devices etc. are not allowed in the school.
 14. The school is not responsible for the loss of books, money, clothes, and other valuable articles.
 15. Exemption for pupils from attending assembly or PT will only be granted with written permission from the Principal.
 16. Every student is expected to speak only in English in the school campus.
 17. Scribbling on the bench/desk/ wall/ doors and windows are strictly prohibited. Spitting and washing through the window is forbidden.
 18. No gift or donation to be given to the teachers and friends.
 19. It is forbidden to buy eatables from street vendors.
 20. Fighting and using abusive languages are strictly prohibited.
 21. Habitual absence and irregularity in home work will be recorded and necessary action will be taken.
 22. Disobedience in any manner is punishable
 23. Children should not involve in robbery, cheating and forging signature.
 24. Loitering around in and outside the school campus during and after the class hours is prohibited.

25. Additional body piercings are not permitted, for example eyebrows, nose, ear etc.
26. Students availing leave should submit a parent's requisition letter along with the leave letter.
27. Absence without a leave letter and late coming shall be considered as a punishable offence. Habitual late comers shall not be allowed to attend school.
28. Whenever a call is made to the parents from the school in connection with the child's work or conduct or misbehavior at school, the parent is requested to respond to the same in the interest of their child.
29. Any unethical activities, behaviors inside the campus will be dealt with seriously and may result in immediate dismissal from the school.
30. Moral character of high order is required of any person inside the campus.
31. Pupils shall not absent themselves from any organized school activities or events like sports day, annual day, toppers day etc., without the prior permission from the principal.

B) TO PARENTS :

We expect fullest support and co-operation from the parents in ensuring an effective education to their wards. This can be achieved by ensuring the following :

1. The parents are always welcome to discuss with the principal about the academic progress, behavior and any other problems of their ward with prior appointment.
2. Parents are directed to attend all the PTA/Open House Parents Meeting in school premises when required without fail.
3. Parents can contact the class teacher and the subject teacher personally with the prior permission from the Principal. Kindly don't disturb the class by visiting their ward in the class room.
4. Parents, kindly send a leave application to the class teacher well in advance. In case of any unavoidable circumstance, they can inform the same to the respective class teacher over phone and send the leave application on the next day.
5. Parents are requested to ensure that their ward attends the school with neat, clean and tidy school uniform.
6. Parents kindly ensure that your child wears the ID card regularly.

7. Parents kindly don't send your ward to school if they are unwell due to any infection or communicable disease or otherwise.
8. Parents kindly don't give any item, things of high value (costly) to your ward.
9. Parents are requested to make all remittances directly to the school office only and get proper receipts for the same.
10. Responsibility of sending the ward to school on time rests on the parent / guardian.
11. Responsibility of the ceases immediately after the school is closed.
12. Parents are expected to present with formal dress in our campus.

C) UNIFORM RULES

1. Full uniform should be worn always inside the school campus with ID-tag.
2. Use only the shoes issued by the school and as prescribed in the timetable.
3. If any skin allergy problem, use only uniform color cotton socks with prior permission.
4. Wearing fancy and gold ornaments are not permitted.
5. Different hair styles and any kind of makeup are not allowed.
6. Boys should have proper and normal haircut.
7. Elder boys should be clean shaved.
8. No alteration in the uniform pants shaped into tight fitting should not be done.
9. Polish the shoes daily.
10. Parents should see that your ward is wearing washed and ironed uniform.
11. Girl's hair must be plaited on both sides, neatly with black ribbon, sport uniform white ribbon. If short, comb neatly and wear black thick hair band. Clips should also be black in color.
12. All students should have a handkerchief. KG students (boys & girls) must have it pinned on their uniform (left hand side of their shirt.)

D) ATTENDANCE

1. The minimum attendance required for promotion is 85 %
2. Absence due to inevitable circumstances will be condoned only on receipt of a written leave application by parents. Leave on medical grounds must be supported by a medical leave.
3. A pupil coming late by more than ten minutes, shall be considered to have been absent for half a day.
4. No half day leave for any students except in grave emergency shall be granted.
5. Absence without leave letter shall render the students liable for fines as per the norms of the school.
6. Attendance of students on all working day is mandatory.

E) SURPRISE CHECKS

The school will organize surprise checks periodically for the students of classes I – XII for their safety. They will be checked for money, electronic gadgets and also for the precision instruments like blade, scissors and knife. If the above items are found, they will be withheld by the school and severe actions will be taken.
